Gloucester County Recognized for Digital Distinction

Gloucester County was recognized in the top-ten ranking of localities (up to 150,000 population category) for the 2018 Digital Counties Survey conducted by the Center for Digital Government and the National Association of Counties. Gloucester was one of six localities in Virginia to be recognized in this category.

The award recognizes localities for their technology policies and practices. The survey identifies and evaluates the best technology practices among counties including initiatives that streamline delivery of government services, openness/transparency, citizen-centered experience, collaboration and shared services, efficiencies and cost control, cyber security and innovation, among other characteristics.

“Effective technology has proven to be a key tool for efficiency in many facets of county government,” said NACo Executive Director Matthew Chase. “We applaud this year’s Digital Counties Survey winners for showcasing the value of innovation and adaptation.
