A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR PUBLIC HEARING THE FY 2010 PROPOSED COUNTY BUDGET AND CY 2009 PROPOSED TAX LEVIES

WHEREAS, the County Administrator has submitted to the Gloucester County Board of Supervisors a proposed annual budget for the County for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010, as required by Section 15.2-1541 of the State Code; and

WHEREAS, a brief synopsis of the budget is required to be published and a public hearing be held as required by the provisions of Section 15.2-2506 of the State Code; and

WHEREAS, a notice to establish real estate and personal property tax levies for calendar year 2009 is required to be published and a public hearing be held; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the County Administrator that calendar year 2009 tax levies be advertised as \$.63 for Real Estate, \$.63 for Mobile Homes, \$.63 for Public Service Corporation Property; \$2.80 for Tangible Personal Property; and \$1.00 for Boats; and

WHEREAS, it is also the recommendation of the County Administrator that calendar year 2009 Ad Valorem tax rates be advertised as \$.01 for the special service districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gloucester County Board of Supervisors this twenty-sixth day of March, 2009, that the County Administrator is authorized to advertise for public hearing the FY 2010 Proposed County Budget and the suggested CY 2009 Proposed Tax Levies.
