Business Beautification Award



The purpose of the Business Beautification award is to recognize businesses in Gloucester County that take pride in the visual impression they leave on the surrounding neighborhood, that show an awareness of the environment, that maintain a clean and attractive site, and that support a cleaner community.

Up to three awards are presented to Gloucester County Businesses twice a year. An effort is made to recognize businesses from the lower, middle and upper sections of the county each time the awards are given. The businesses that are nominated have to demonstrate an on-going effort to maintain a clean and well groomed business free from litter, clutter, and general debris. They also take responsibility by providing trash receptacles that are adequate for collecting the garbage that may be generated by their clientele.

Criteria

- Must have been in business at the present location in Gloucester County for at least one year.
- Must be in compliance with all county codes
- Must have had building renovations and/or landscaping for at least one year.

Landscaping—Landscaping on the property must be well maintained, healthy, and of appropriate scale for building or buildings.

Litter control—The area must be litter and clutter free. Trash and cigarette butt receptacles must be adequate for collecting the amount of trash that may be generated through the services they provide and customers they serve. Areas of concern include ditches, parking lots, walkways and loading docks.

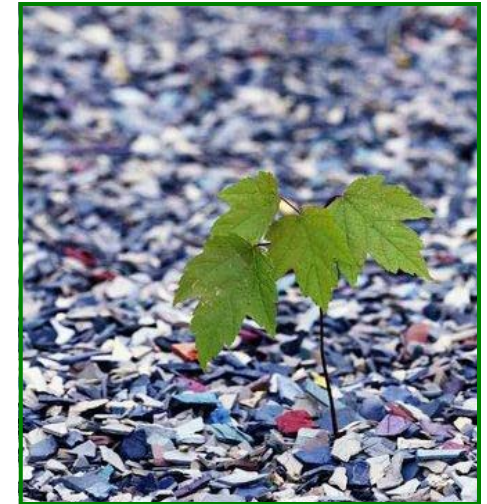
Signage—Signs should fit in with overall building design and be consistent in style and lettering.



Recycling—File the business recycling report in a timely fashion.
