

## BEAVERDAM PARK PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

MOONLIGHT FISHING                      Friday      June 5      6 PM – MIDNIGHT

Take advantage of the cool night temperatures and calm waters at Beaverdam. Moonlight fishing will be held on Friday June 5<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm until midnight. Enter the park using the main entrance only; the Farys Mill Road (Rt. 606) entrance will close at 8:30 PM. The fee is \$5 per person or per boat, persons under 18 are free.

FREE FISHING DAY                      Saturday      June 6                      9 AM – NOON

The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Wal-Mart and Beaverdam Park are sponsoring a free day of fishing for children 4 – 14 years of age. Register by calling Beaverdam at 693-2107. There is space for 75 participants. Check in will begin at 8:30 AM. No licenses are required statewide during the first weekend in June. A Conservation Police Officer will provide poles, bait and lunch to registered participants at the main entrance of the park on Roaring Springs Road.

PADDLE JAM                                      Sunday      June 21                      8 AM – NOON

Beaverdam will again be the site of the competitive canoe races that make up Paddle Jam. Long (4 miles) and short (2 miles) races are open to one and two person canoes and kayaks. Additional 'fun' races will be held. The first race is off at 9 AM. Fees are \$15 if received before June 5 and \$20 after the early registration date.
