

BEAVERDAM PARK PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

MOONLIGHT FISHING Friday May 8 6 PM – Midnight

Take advantage of the cool night temperatures and calm waters at Beaverdam. Moonlight fishing will be held on Friday May 8th, June 5th, July 3rd, August 7th and September 4th from 6 pm until midnight. **Note:** All navigation lights are required on boats during Moonlight Fishing. Enter the park using the main entrance only; the Farys Mill Road (Rt. 606) entrance will close at 8:30 PM. The fee is \$5 per person or per boat, persons under 18 are free.

TRAIL RUN Sunday May 17 2 PM

The multiuse trail at Beaverdam runs nearly ten miles through varying wooded terrain. The race will begin at the 606 entrance to the park (Parking is limited at the starting line). A shuttle will be provided to take runners from the Main Entrance and Botetourt Elementary School to the starting line. *Advance registration is requested*, Deadline Wednesday, May 13. MOONLIGHT CANOEING Friday May 22 8 – 10PM

Paddle Beaverdam Lake after dark and see wildlife not active during normal park hours. The two-hour ranger lead trip begins with elementary canoe instruction and then it's off to explore. Program meets at the Park's main entrance. Registration deadline is Wednesday May 20,. Fee \$10. Not recommended for children under age 5. *Advance registration is required.*
