6pm – midnight

Take advantage of the cool night temperatures & calm waters at Beaverdam. Moonlight fishing will be held on Friday August 1st and September 5th from 6 pm until midnight. Note: You do need navigation lights on your boat at Beaverdam, red & green running lights & an all around white light. Please enter the park at the main entrance only, located at the end of Roaring Springs Road (Rt. 616). The Fary's Mill Road (Rt. 606) entrance is not accessible for moonlight fishing.

CREATURES OF THE BLACK LAGOON **Sunday, September 7** **2 - 4 PM**

We will catch tadpoles, salamanders and other pond species for our aquariums. Help to find suitable critters for display and set them up in their temporary homes. Our staff will go along to the berm areas to explore a part of the varied habitat of the park.
