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### **ALERT: Tax Deadlines EXTENDED**

The Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service announced today that they are pushing the tax filing deadline to July 15, 2020 for all Americans due to the COVID-19 Outbreak.

The IRS reminds individual taxpayers the easiest and fastest way to request a filing extension is to electronically file Form 4868 through their tax professional, tax software or using the Free File link on [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov). Businesses must file Form 7004.

This relief only applies to federal taxes, including tax on self-employment income. It does not apply to state tax payments or deposits or payments. Taxpayers will also need to file income tax returns in 42 states plus the District of Columbia. State filing and payment deadlines vary and are not always the same as the federal filing deadline. The IRS urges taxpayers to check with their state tax agencies for those details. More information is available at <https://www.taxadmin.org/state-tax-agencies>.
