MRC: The volunteers that assisted with PPE fit testing, monitoring proper social distancing measures and assistance with ensuring proper sanitization on Chief Pick-up Day and throughout Election Day went well and we received compliments that face masks, face shields, social distancing was in action and made for a very smooth process!

BALLOT DROP BOX: Please do not use the Treasurer's Drop Box to return your ballot. We now have a New Vote-By-Mail Ballot Drop Box available 24/7 and securely located at the back of our Building that allows you to return your ballot without any in-person contact and to know we received your ballot successfully!

OFFICE MOVE: Our newly expanded space is designed to accommodate recent changes to State code, and facilitate a safer, more convenient voter experience. The Registrar's office is still located in the same County Office Building #1 but is now on the first floor of the building rather than the second floor. A huge thank you to the Facilities Management, IT and Safety Departments for making this a success.
